**'Missing in America' wins four awards at Monaco film fest**

Filmmaker and Big Timber native Gabrielle Savage Dockterman's debut feature film, "Missing in America," swept the awards ceremony at the Monaco International Film Festival recently, winning four prizes, including the grand prize for best film. "Missing in America" debuted in Montana at the Hatch Fest in October.

The film, which stars Danny Glover, David Strathairn, Linda Hamilton, Ron Perlman, and newcomer Zoe Weizenbaum (who plays a principal role in "Memoirs of a Geisha"), will be released on video and DVD across North America on Jan. 10.

Glover plays a Vietnam veteran who is haunted by memories of lives lost under his command. While living in exile in the forests of the Pacific Northwest, he is faced with a life-changing decision after a former platoon member and his young Amerasian daughter visit him.

This is the first time ever an American has won the Angel Awards Trophy for best film at the Monaco International Film Festival, presented Dec. 11 at the Theatre Princesse Grace in Monte Carlo. Glover received best actor honors, best actress went to Weizenbaum and best director for Dockterman.

Dockterman has won several other awards for her film, including the Audience Award for Emerging Director at both the St. Louis International Film Festival in November, and the Woods Hole Film Festival in August. She also accepted the Screen Actor's Guild award for Emerging Actress on behalf of Zoe Weizenbaum at the St. Louis International Film Festival, while Weizenbaum was in Western Massachusetts accepting her award for Best New Actress, New England at the Northampton Film Festival.
